



## When It Is Hard To Worship

There is an old joke that talks about a man who wakes up one Sunday and doesn't want to go to church. When his wife asks him why not, he says, "I'll give you two reasons. First, they don't like me, and second, I don't like them." His wife replied, "I'll give you two reasons why you should go to church. First, you are a grown man, and second, you are the preacher."

I get it. We all have days when we don't feel like going to church. Maybe you woke up grouchy. Maybe you had a fight with your spouse. Maybe things in your life have been one speedbump after another. Whatever it is, you just don't feel like going to worship and putting on a happy face.

Sometimes the church puts out the message that since Christians are saved we are always supposed to be happy. People ask us how we are doing and we are supposed to say, "I'm great!" The songbook in our pews is called Songs of Faith and Praise. Some churches even have a praise team.

But what happens when you aren't doing great and when your praises fall flat on your lips? Do you hide in a corner and hope nobody talks to you? Do you not sing? And if you do sing praises, does that make you a hypocrite? Wouldn't it just be better if you skipped worship when you are sad?

I believe that when we are sad, suffering, and alone we may need to worship more than ever. The book of Psalms (the songbook of Israel) is filled with laments written by those who were sick, in pain, hounded by enemies, or just plain confounded by evil. Their psalms start as cries to God to fix and to heal. And the cries, the songs, are meant to be sung in the midst of the people.

Worship is not about a bunch of happy people coming together expressing one long ode to joy. It is about bringing the fullness of our lives in joy and in pain, in thanksgiving and in suffering, in strength and in weakness, and laying them down before God. If we are hurting, who better to share that with than a brother or sister in Christ? If we need to weep, there is no safer space than in the church.

So what do you do when your heart doesn't feel like singing the praise songs we usually sing? You can sit back and listen. I find it very comforting to hear the voices of believers express their faith and praise when I am at a low point. Or you can join in and let your heart catch up to your faith at its own pace; there is nothing wrong or hypocritical in that. One of the reasons that we come together every Sunday is to receive the blessing of encouragement from other believers, and music has a power that few other things do.

And if you are suffering or depressed, please don't feel that you must keep that to yourself. If you can't immediately think of someone to share that with, take it to one of the elders at our invitation time. They are the shepherds of the flock and want to tend to your needs.

Finally, know that you are not alone. Others are hurting as well, or have been in your shoes before you. We all want to sing a lament at some time. Share your burden with us. Share your burden with God. Let the healing begin.
