The Bread of Life class was started years ago by Shane Mountjoy. The premise of the class is to read through different books of the Bible, discuss each chapter and talk about what is happening within the chapter and also talk about how we can apply that to our lives. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 tells us where scripture comes from and how it should be used.

"All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work."

Believing that all scripture comes from God allows us to have faith in the word, use it, and apply it to our lives. In this class, we start by reading the scriptures aloud. There's something that happens when scriptures are read aloud. I think we hear things differently than when we just read on our own. Every time we read the Bible, no matter how many

times we've read it before, it's possible to pick up on something different. Depending on where we are in life, what's happening in life at that moment, the scriptures speak to us in different ways. When we do this in a group setting, it allows us to learn from all the experiences from everyone in the room. As a result of this process, not only do we learn from one another, we build relationships and grow closer to one another.

We're starting a new section in class today, Proverbs. This is a discussion class where we all have the opportunity to read and share about what we're hearing, believing, and how we can apply the words in our lives. Proverbs 1 begins with a statement of purpose; to impart wisdom for godly living. I'm looking forward to the discussion. If you weren't able to be in class today, we look forward to seeing you next week.
