



Shooting for Funny

Have you had those moments when your intentions are to be funny, but as soon as you say it, you know you missed? Recently, I had one of those moments. I thought my comment was hilarious, but I could tell by the reaction that it was not hilarious to both of us. Immediately I regretted my comment. I was shooting for funny, but I hit rude. I often hear this kind of "humor" from other people, too. Why do we say the things we say? Why do we go to put downs covered in sarcasm to get a laugh at another's expense? In our minds...maybe we think we're funny, not rude, and not hurtful, so it's ok, but really it's not. I'd like to challenge each of you to think about how powerful your words are and look for opportunities to lift those up around you. Make this your new normal and adopt a philosophy of "No Put Downs." Use your words to build others up.

Paul gives us a lot of instructions in Ephesians 4:29-32. He tells us exactly how to behave toward one another, and there is a lot more to it than just watching our words.

Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen. And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, with whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

Things to do...

- Build others up with your words.
- Meet the needs of others.
- Show love to other people.
- Control your temper and your words.
- Be gentle.
- Tell the truth.
- Do the right thing.
- Be kind.
- Be compassionate.
- Show empathy to others and their situation.
- Forgive.

Look for opportunities to build others up, serve others, love others, and forgive others. It won't be easy, but life isn't about doing what's easy, it's about doing what's right.
