



# Paul's Prayer for the Church in Ephesus

In the scriptures, we have recorded for us a number of prayers for the early churches. I recently read Paul's prayer and thanksgiving for the church in Ephesus (Ephesians 1:15-19) and wanted to pray that for East Hill.

First of all is thankfulness for the faith and love of the church.

15 For this reason, ever since I heard about your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all God's people, 16 I have not stopped giving thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers.

I am so very thankful for the body of believers here at East Hill. The faith that is shown every week as we gather together is so encouraging. The love and support that is expressed to one another in the conversations before and after services lifts me up and I too want to give thanks for each and every one of you in my prayers.

Next is asking God to give us his Spirit so that we may know Him better.

17 I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better.

Praying that we all know God and Jesus Christ better is very important. We can do this with our daily bible reading as well as our time together in bible study and worship. My prayer is that we all continue to grow in our knowledge of God and Jesus Christ.

Paul continues his prayer that the eyes of their heart may be enlightened.

18 I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, 19 and his incomparably great power for us who believe.

I will consider this a prayer that we fully understand God and His plan for us. Paul first wants us to know the hope that we have through Christ and that God truly wants us to be a part of His family. Not only that we understand our hope in the Lord but also that we participate in the blessings of being a part of that inheritance. Paul's description of the "riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people" is so powerful. As a body of believers we are blessed being a part of God's family. Then Paul reminds us that we share in God's great power if we believe in him. We have access to this power through our prayers. Paul goes on to describe that power in the remainder of the first chapter of Ephesians.

That power is the same as the mighty strength 20 he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms, 21 far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is invoked, not only in the present age but also in the one to come. 22 And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church, 23 which is his body, the fullness of him who fills everything in every way.

My prayer is that we all could grow and understand all of this as we continue to worship together and support each other in our faith journey. ~Todd Sheldon
