

A New Command

When Jesus was with his disciples for the last supper, he gave them what he called a new command, but today we have heard this often, to love one another.

John 13:34-35

“A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.”

In 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 (NIV) Paul says:
