



How to...From Paul

When Paul writes to the Philippians, he has specific instructions in Chapter 2 that are very encouraging. If you've had those moments when you feel discouraged, I recommend you consult Philippians Chapter 2. He opens by telling them that if they have any encouragement from being united in Christ, any comfort from his love, any common sharing in the spirit, any tenderness and compassion they should make his joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, and to be one in spirit and of one mind. This is a strong call for unity to us; to come together with our common belief.

So how do we do that? Verse 3 begins with words to live by, "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit.

Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of others." And if that's not enough of a picture, he continues, "In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus:

Who being in very nature God,
did not consider equality with God
something to be used to his own advantage;
rather he made himself nothing
by taking the very nature of a servant,
being made in human likeness.
And being found in appearance as a man,
he humbled himself
by becoming obedient to death—
even death on a cross!"

The world tells us to do things for ourselves. It tells us to seek the praise and the credit for what we do; to make it all about ourselves. But, Paul spells it out for us. We need to look to grow closer to one another. We need to look for opportunities to serve one another. We need to be doing things because it's the right thing to do, not because it will make us look good. Paul tells us to have the same mindset as Christ. No pressure, but the example is how Jesus came here and humbled himself by becoming human and then was obedient to death on the cross. From this section, Paul tells us that we need to look for those opportunities to be with other Christians. We need to value others above ourselves and follow the example of Jesus by humbling ourselves.

As you move forward throughout the week, be intentional with the way you talk to others, work with others, perceive others and truly value them above yourself. In doing so, you'll be serving others and serving God by following the example of Jesus.
