



This is Fellowship

I believe you learn how to follow Christ by belonging to and participating in a church. In other words, you can't faithfully follow Christ all on your own. You'll remember the Jerusalem Church in Acts and how they devoted themselves to the Apostle's teaching (Bible study) and to fellowship (Acts 2:42-47). They did life and faith together. I want to refocus on the fellowship aspect of being a church. Fellowship is more than going to social activities. Fellowship is a participation in a common goal. This is what the Jerusalem Church was known for: working toward the common goal of lifting one another for Christ.
