



Let the Women Learn

In 1 Timothy 2:11, the Greek word for 'let learn' is 'mathaneto'. The mood form of the word is an imperative, that is, a command that women are to learn. We see this same word in another key scripture, Matthew 28:19, where we are told to go make disciples (matheteusate). What God commands, we have no choice but to obey.

Why might God's highest calling for women be that they are to learn? Women are co-heirs with men (Genesis 1:28), to care for this earth, to be fruitful and multiply God's image makers, which is all of mankind. It is both a spiritual and a physical job and an allencompassing task.

Proof of the blessings of this learning was on full display this past weekend at the East Hill Women's Retreat. Tucked away at beautiful Fort Timberlake, under the leadership and servant hearts of Ana Caravalho and Diana Kretz, women unpacked their wisdom, joys, sorrows, and lived experiences with one another. Beautiful singing echoed throughout the weekend under Kay Magner's song leading. We heard life testimonies from Holly Rinard, Leanna Hawley and Cheryl Mogul. Each testimony helped better equip other women for life's journey. Diana taught strategies for handling anxiety and depression through the lens of God's Word. Laughter and joy filled the air as sisters shared stories of how they met their husbands and other assorted topics. Anessa Westbrook shared about hope in Sunday's worship service. Brenda Sikes focused our thoughts around communion. Each sister served others bringing her unique *learning* to the retreat. Nancy Knight tirelessly helped with meals; an assortment of needs were met by each woman ranging from crafts to transportation.

Women often get the cultural message they have less value if they are not paid for what they do, or are not in a public role, or are not able to have authority over men. None of the women who served over the weekend received any such acknowledgements. Yet each one shined to God's glory as they blessed other women with the gift of their own *learning*. It was mentioned that the church is impacted by the world's culture and how we must intentionally assess that culture. Our role as women is to *learn* what God's will is and to help one another and our families to live-out God's culture, regardless how different that may be.

Anessa used 1 Peter 1:13-16 to stress how our minds are to be prepared for action. We have hope and we must be holy as God is holy. Christians have throughout time been known as people who live differently, often shining like stars in the dark world around them. (Philippians 2:15)

We have a hope that is grounded in scripture, unseen, visible to others and confident.

Each of the sisters at the retreat is a living light of the stars we have here at East Hill. We thank the men who served (especially Paulo and Ron), supported and loved each of these women so they could be poured into and enjoy a restorative time away.
