



The Delight of God

Last week, Glenn preached about Isaiah's prophetic redemption for the people of Israel: "You shall no more be termed Forsaken, and your land shall no more be termed Desolate, but you shall be called My Delight Is in Her (Hephzibah), and your land Married (Beulah); for the LORD delights in you, and your land shall be married." Isaiah 62:4 (ESV)

Glenn pointed out that this same redemptive act by God is seen in Rev. 2:13-17 — those who remain true to God's name, who do not renounce their faith but overcome, will be given a white stone with a new name on it. Both scripture references are beautiful imageries of receiving a new identity from God, his favor, his delight.

The word "delight" isn't your average social media *like* or thumbs-up emoji. To me, God's delight conveys deep emotional ties and a vested interest in the welfare and future of his chosen, his children. I picture a Father who smiles and derives pleasure when his child is walking a path that honors him and in turn, he prepares blessings for the journey.

Moved by the Spirit, Zephaniah takes it up a level with his beautiful description of God's delight: "The Lord your God is with you, he is mighty to save. He will take great delight in you, he will quiet you with his love, he will rejoice over you with singing." Zeph. 3:17 (NIV)

Holding my newborn grandson in my arms these last few weeks, I easily relate to that passage. Spencer Jack may not grasp my delight in him, and my songs may or may not quiet his cries; nonetheless, he is my world in those moments. I want to abundantly bless his future and for him to know the joy of my heart.

This morning, we have a distinct privilege to witness what James, the brother of Jesus, describes as *pure religion* with the Odom Family blessing. David and Rachel are providing a heavenly view into God's heart, his delight as they have given a new name, their name to Skyler, Nathan, and Isaac.

A few days ago, several of us from East Hill along with many of David and Rachel's family, were able to witness the adoption proceedings. At one point, Rachel was asked by their lawyer the simple but pointed question, "Can you tell us why you want to adopt the children?" I'm not able to recall everything that Rachel said, but I do remember her last words: "We can't imagine life without them."

"Even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes. God decided in advance to adopt us into his own family by bringing us to himself through Jesus Christ. This is what he wanted to do, and it gave him great pleasure." Ephesians 1:4-5 (NLT)
