

Reflecting on the Word "DAILY"

The theme verse of the year picked by the Elders for East Hill is, *"Then he said to them all: If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross DAILY and follow me"* (Luke 9:23).

In a recent sermon by Glenn Hawley, he mentioned one of the reasons they chose it over a similar verse in the Gospels was that it includes the word "DAILY." So I got to thinking about that. Did you know that the word "DAILY" is mentioned 30 times in the NIV translation of the Bible?

There are DAILY burnt offerings to be made in Numbers 28. The people were required to give the necessary items to the priests so they could offer DAILY burnt offerings to the Lord, once in the morning and once in the evening. Why? The Lord wants us to worship him every day, and to go to him with our sins DAILY. He wants us to realize that he can give us rest and forgiveness from those sins DAILY.

In Psalms 68:19, it says, "Praise be to the Lord, to God our Savior, who DAILY bears our burdens." He helps us every day with our burdens. Not just on Tuesdays or Sundays but every day. The Lord thinks about you and is blessing you every single day! WOW!


In Matthew 6, Jesus teaches us how to pray with the Lord's Prayer, which says, "Give us today our DAILY bread." Have you ever noticed the word "DAILY" before? It doesn't say "give us tomorrow's bread" or "yesterday's bread," but says "today's bread." So do not worry about yesterday or tomorrow, focus on the DAILY bread God provides. That is how it works; each day, he supplies our needs.

So, back to the verse that the elders picked for East Hill this year. It says to DAILY deny yourself. Yep, that's right, you must lose yourself every day. So, if I lose, I win? Yep, right again. If you lay down your sins, your needs, your sorrows, and your joys in front of him, DAILY, he will give you your life. He will bless you with eternal life. Amen!

We can't forget the last half of that verse. What does it mean to take up his cross DAILY? We have to obey his commands like Jesus did before he took up his cross. We have to serve one another the way Jesus served those around him. We have to do this DAILY.

Every day for years and years may seem overwhelming in some ways, but not if you take it DAILY. One day at a time is God's design for us.
