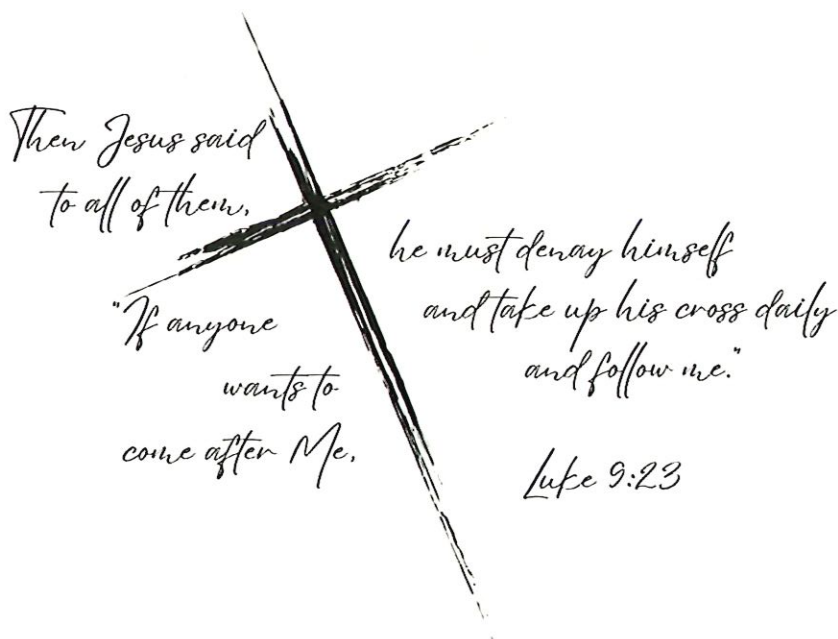
BODY LIFE & PRAYERS
