

Communion

Last Sunday the elders and ministers met for one of our April meetings. We began our time together sharing what prayer concerns God had placed on our hearts, followed by a time of prayer for the East Hill family. Our agenda for this meeting consisted of one main item: Communion time at East Hill. After seeking input, studying the Scriptures, and praying for guidance, we all felt it was time to determine what our time communing at the Lord's Table at East Hill should look like. Several different ideas were shared, and through visiting about them we decided on a plan we believe will be good for our church body.

- On the first Sunday of every month, we will observe the Lord's Supper by passing the emblems. A presider will share thoughts designed to lead us to the Table. After the prayer of blessing for each emblem, the trays will be passed. We will not be passing a tray for the offering at this time. After the Lord's Supper the presider will lead a prayer for the offering and invite the children to come up.
- On each of the other Sundays we will continue to observe the Lord's Supper at the tables as we have been doing, but with a few changes. People will still be welcome to partake with the pre-packaged emblems or the little trays and have them at their seats.
 - Each week there will be a scripture on the "Communion" slide.
 - A presider will share some thoughts designed to lead us to the Table. They will pray for the bread and the cup; the body and the blood of Jesus.
 - After the presider finishes praying, the congregation will have a period of silence for

personal reflection and meditation before anyone gets up to go to the tables.

- At the proper time, on the "Communion" slide on the screens, there will be an invitation to come share in communion at the tables.
- All are encouraged not to rush this time. We want for this to be a time where we, as God's redeemed, spend a few minutes uplifting one another.
- To close this portion of the service, the worship leader might lead a song as we return to our seats, or the presider may call us back and prepare for the children's offering. He will pray for the offering and invite the children up.

For the offering, we will be adding collection boxes at the back of the auditorium. There will be no collection trays passed on the first Sundays and there will no longer be collection trays on the tables.

This new format is a mixture of the familiar with the addition of elements we believe will enrich the time that we share each Sunday morning communing at the Lord's Table. Thank you for sharing with us and praying for us as we considered how to best honor God and serve the East Hill body.
