

Times of Transition

Transition: to change from one form, state, style, or place to another. As we go through life, we often experience times of transition. Sometimes the changes are minor and don't really have a big impact on our lives. For example, "My favorite pair of shoes finally wore out and now I must adjust to a new pair." At other times the transitions carry a much greater impact. When we are changing jobs and moving to a new part of the country, it requires a lot more adjustment.

As the East Hill Church of Christ family, we find ourselves in a time of transition—a pretty significant transition. We are experiencing the immediate effects of moving from having two full-time ministers to having one. Along with that we are looking at the long-term impact of answering the question, "Where do we go from here?" Glenn Dalmann's daily impact as a minister at East Hill was great and will be missed. He was originally hired to serve as our Worship and Family Minister and focused on those areas for many years. Recently his title was changed to more closely align to the areas where he was spending a significant amount of his time: Outreach and Involvement. His focus was on community outreach and helping to equip others to evangelize, as well as mentoring and providing pastoral counseling, preaching and teaching classes, visiting and connecting members and visitors, and encouraging member involvement. He also continued to help with the organization of our Sunday morning worship.

Glenn Hawley and the office staff are working to cover the gaps where they can, and we have hired Simeon Tremaine part-time to help in the organization of our

Sunday worship times. But the big vacancy in our minister staff can only be filled by hiring another minister. The elders are in the process of developing a plan to start a minister search. As we begin to consider this process the main question we want to start with is, "What are the needs of the East Hill church that we would like a full-time minister to help us with?"

We are at the very beginning of this process and would like to invite you to be involved. At this point, there are two main areas we ask you to join us in. First, join us in prayer as we seek the Lord's guidance as we travel down this path. Second, please take some time to consider the question, "What does the East Hill Church need in an additional minister?" Take some time to think about this question and then please share your thoughts with the Elders.

We serve an Amazing God and believe that He has great plans for the family here at East Hill.

Proverbs 3:5-6 reminds us: *"Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths."*

Father God, we come to You asking for guidance and direction as we begin the process of looking for an additional minister to join us in our work at East Hill. We are excited to see the amazing plans You have for us. And we draw comfort in this time of TRANSITION that we serve a God who NEVER changes!
