

Loving Others Day to Day

Life is not easy. How do we do it? How do we deal with difficult situations? How do we serve others? We do it through love. Why do we need to?

We are called to love each other. 1 John 4:7-8 tells us, *"Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love."* The love here is referring to Agape. Agape love is selfless and unconditional. We are called to love one another.

What is Agape love and how do we show it? 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 is often used in wedding ceremonies, but since this is speaking of Agape love, it applies to everyone we meet, everyone we know. Don't forget verses 1-3. *"If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal. If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. If I give all I possess to the poor and give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing."* There is a lot we can do that is good, but if we do not have love, none of it matters.

Continuing on, what is love? *"Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away."* (Remember- Love never fails.)

I want to encourage you to apply these principles whenever you encounter people. Be patient. Be kind. Be happy when good things happen for other people, and don't put your own good accomplishments out in the open to take the attention. When working with others, there might be some tough truths that need to be said, but do so in a way that still honors them. A phrase I learned a long time ago is, "I love you too much to let you..." This is a great opener for sharing tough things that others need to hear. In doing so, you will be protecting them, you will share in a way that builds trust because you are honoring them at the same time, even though you are sharing hard truths. When you continue to show this kind of love, love never fails.

One last thought on working with people in day to day situations; remember Ephesians 4:29. *"Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen."*

This fits with the concepts in 1 John 4: 8-9 and 1 Corinthians 13: 4-8. As you strive to show love to others, be conscious of your words and intentions. Use language and words that will lift others up and encourage others in a way that they may benefit.
