

September 9 Meeting (part 2)

The East Hill family was in its infancy when York College reopened its doors under the administration of the Churches of Christ in 1956. I can think of two of our current members, Marilyn Brown and Ramona Ratliff, who were part of that first congregation that met in their new building (now called Gurganus Hall) at the corner of 10th and Kiplinger Avenue. Seventy years later, the desire of those founding members to expand the impact on our community and broaden our spiritual outreach is alive and well!

The congregational meeting scheduled for Wednesday evening will not only have discussions about the proposed addition of needed office and meeting spaces, but also our vision for supporting a new minister. We were extremely blessed by Glenn Dallmann's 14 years of service at East Hill, the last couple with an emphasis on outreach and involvement. Glenn took the lead in doing personal work with people from the community, and was responsible as well for equipping others to reach out with the Gospel.

After listening to congregational feedback and through prayerful consideration, the elders are committed to serving alongside a minister that will continue that outreach emphasis as well as supporting our youth in their spiritual development. Those who attend the meeting on Wednesday will hear more details about our minister search and receive a description of the man we are seeking to join us in the work at East Hill.

Whether or not you are able to be with us on Wednesday, we would encourage you to be invested in

this process. Be in prayer for wisdom and a spirit of discernment as we move forward in these efforts, and please seek out an elder or talk with Glenn Hawley if you have any questions.

This is an exciting time of possibilities and renewed purpose for the East Hill congregation. The fields are white for harvest and we pray we allow the Lord to use us to grow his Kingdom.
